

The Hatch Back is designed to control two worm gear motors used to lift heavy engine hatches simultaneously. The Hatch Back does this with very little current (approximately 1 amp) carried through the switch.

- 1. Connect the battery used to operate the Hatch lift motors to the Positive and Negative large terminals on the side of the unit (as illustrated).
- 2. Connect the two worm gear motors to the Lift Motor terminals on the lower front of the unit.
- Wire the "ON-OFF-ON" switch (provided) to the small terminals on the top of the unit. The center "tab" of the switch MUST be connected to the center terminal.
- 4. When installing the switch, rotate it so the hatch goes "UP" and "DOWN" with the direction the switch toggle is pushed.

Additional switches will connect the same way.

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
